What is AusGeoTIFF?

AusGeoTIFF are raster images of the Australian Navigational Chart Series in GeoTIFF format. For more information, see *Product Information, Brochure 1*.

What are the Licensing Conditions?

You will be licensed to use *AusGeoTIFF* images for the purposes you state in your *AusGeoTIFF* Application Form, provided that you do not wish to use them for navigation.

By signing a licensing agreement, you will also agree to protect *AusGeoTIFF* (and TIFF) images from illegal copying.

How do I select my chart images?

AusGeoTIFF images can be selected by completing the Chart Selection List at the back of the *AusGeoTIFF* Application Form. If you are not familiar with the coverage of our charts you can find the charts you need by visiting the Australian Chart Index (Electronic) section on our web site at:

How long can I use my chart images?

You will be licensed to use *AusGeoTIFF* images for three years. However, you may cancel your licence and return the images at any time. If you wish to use your *AusGeoTIFF* images for more than three years you can apply to renew your licence.

How do I renew my licence?

You will be sent a renewal offer one month prior to the expiry date of your licence. By renewing your licence you will incur a small *Renewal Fee* to cover the administration costs associated with extending

your licence. See *Brochure 4, Pricing* for more information.

What Site Licences are on offer?

AusGeoTIFF site licences are offered in the following configurations:

- two to five sites,
- six to ten sites
- and greater than ten sites.

What happens when my licence expires?

When your licence expires you will be required to return your original CD media including update CDs. In addition you will be required to destroy any electronic copies that you have made.
